

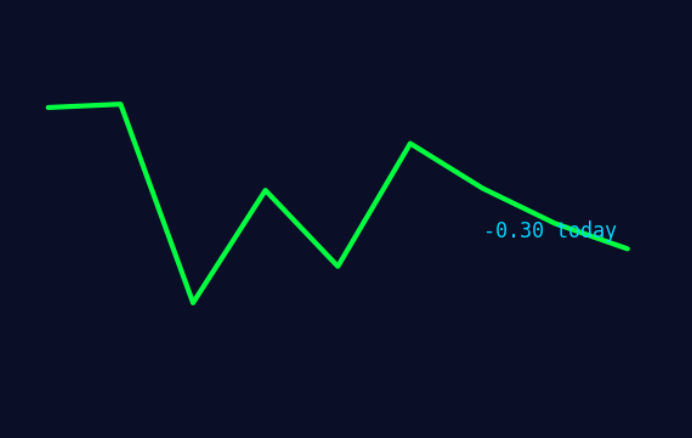

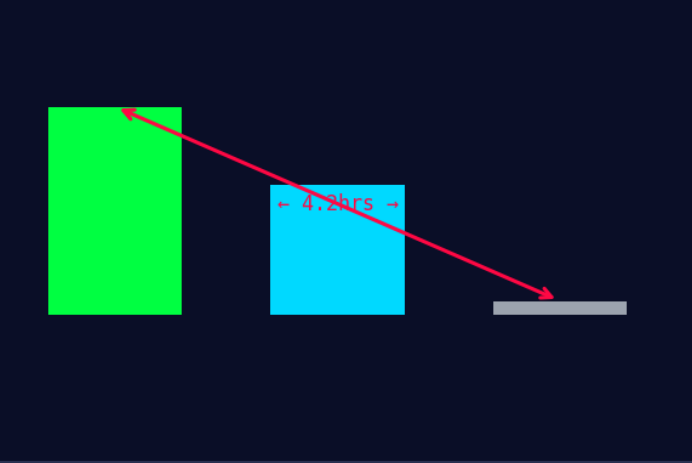

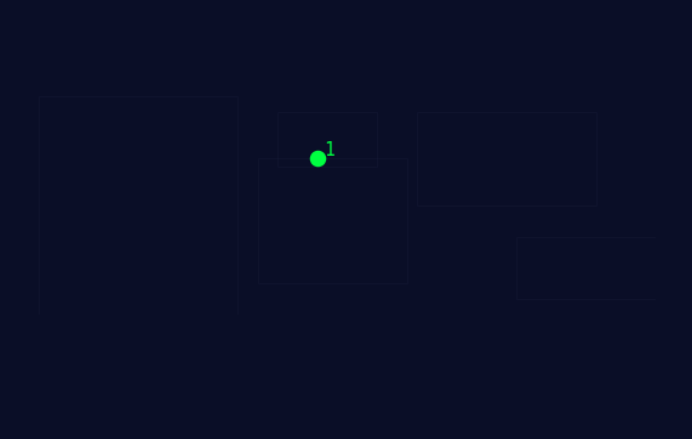
30-DAY TREND

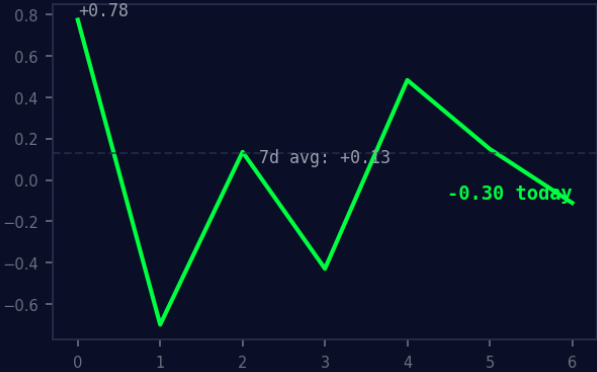

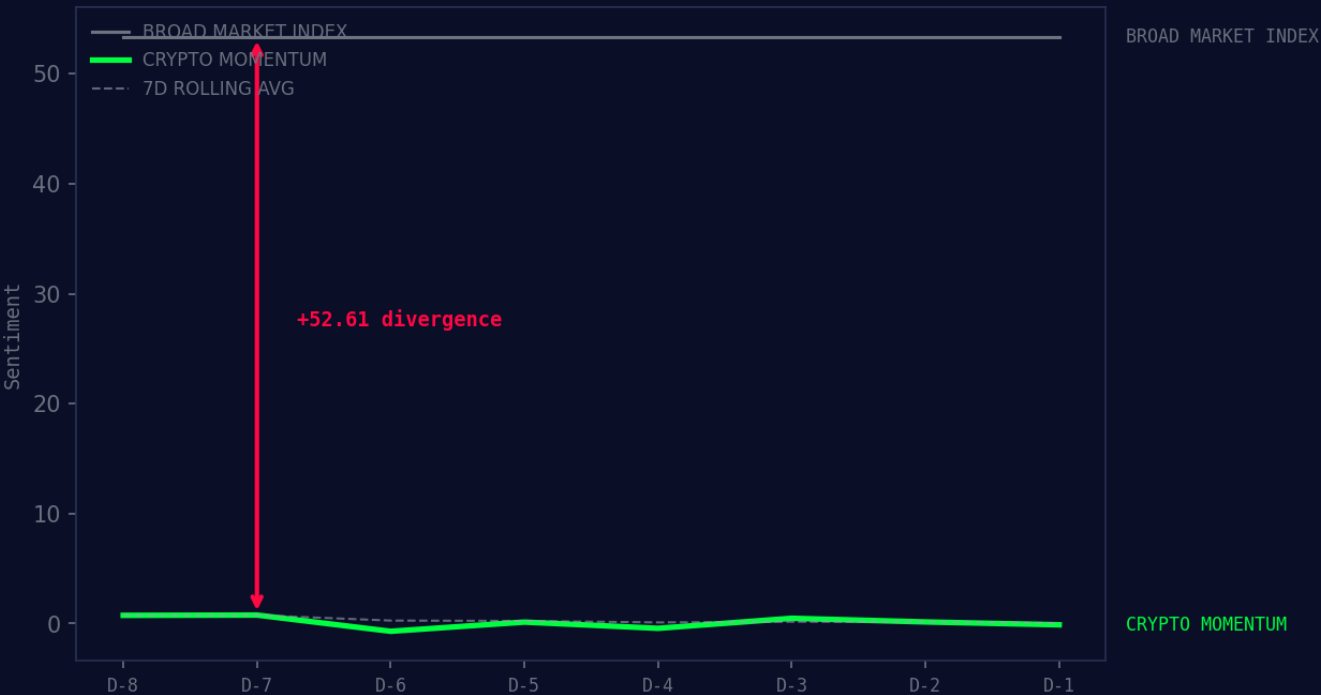
Crypto momentum spike led by Senate, first detected in United States.

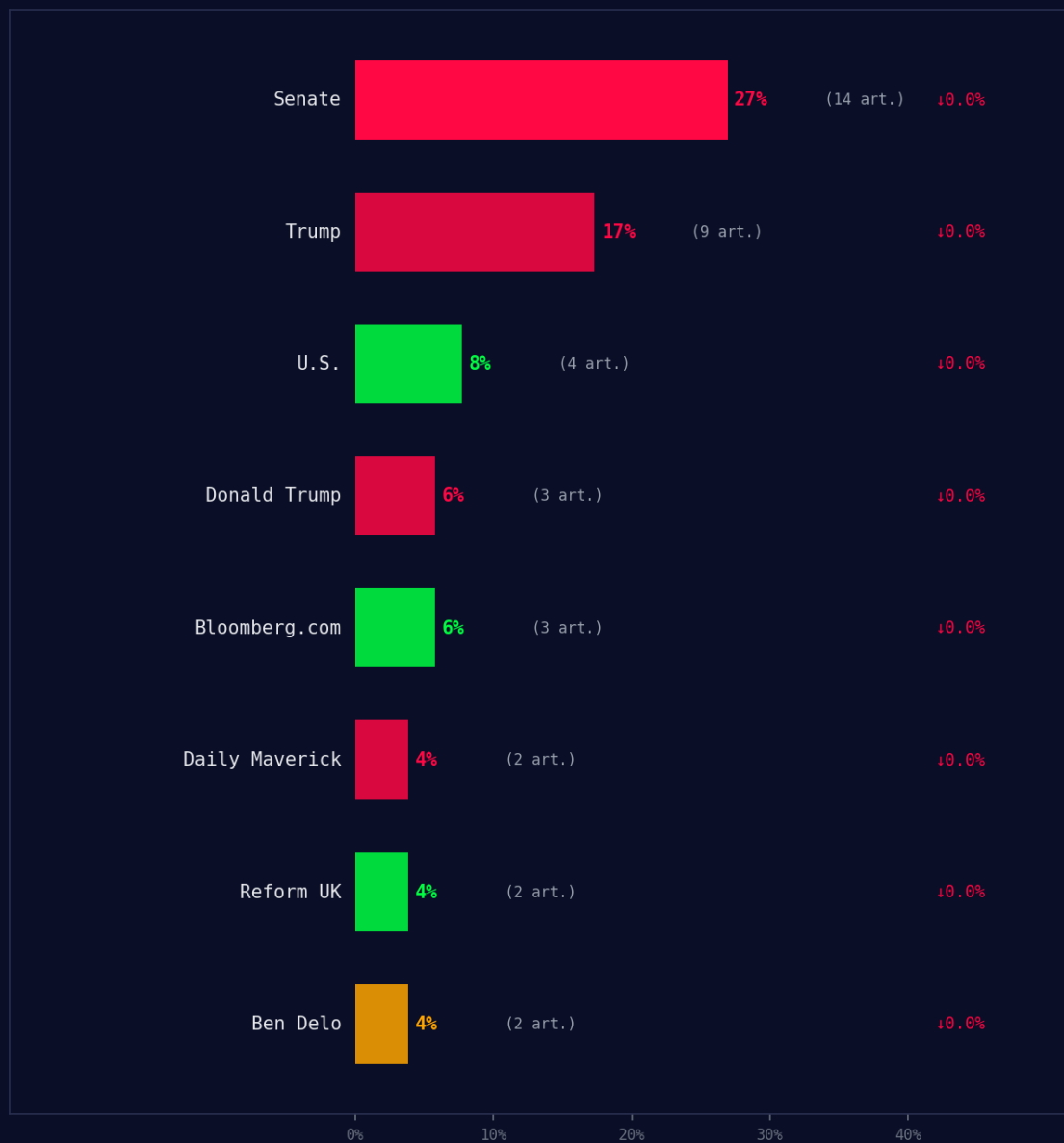

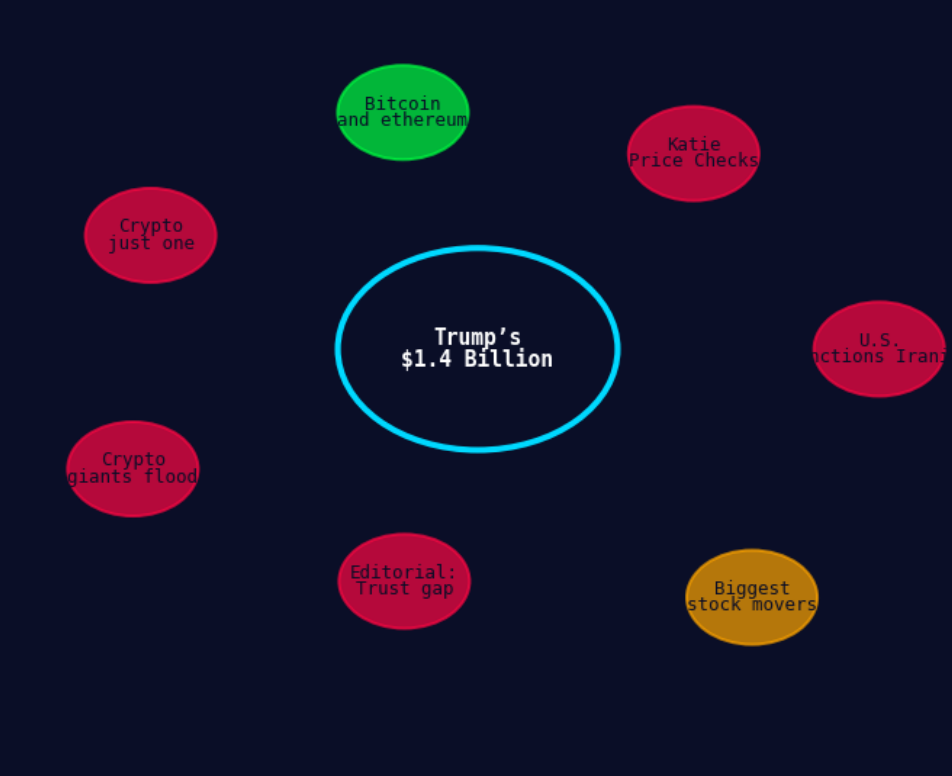
